Swine Rules

- A. All hogs must be blood tested within 90 days of show day and must have an 840 Federal tag.
- B. Market hogs must have DNA submitted by July 15.
- C. All health certificates are to be shown to the swine superintendent BEFORE unloading on the fairgrounds.
- D. Exhibitor must have acquired title and taken possession of all livestock animals on or before the ownership date of July 15.
- E. **Entry deadline – All entries must be submitted by the deadline listed in the General Rules**
- F. No premium money will be issued to swine exhibitors until pens are cleaned and checked by superintendent.
- G. No hay in swine pens.

Section 1: Breeding Swine

Breeds: Berkshire, Hampshire, Hereford, Poland China, Duroc, Spot, Yorkshire, Chester White, AOB

- a) Open Division entry fee is \$2.50 per head. Junior Division-No entry fee
- b) Swine shown in breeding division must be registered.
- c) Gilts in registered breeding division can also be shown in the market hog show.
- d) Three registered gilts will constitute a breed show.
- e) An exhibitor may only show 2 per class.
- f) Superintendent will split breeding swine classes if deemed necessary.

Section 2: Commercial Gilts

- a) Commercial Gilts are defined as any crossbred or any purebred gilt that is ineligible for registration.
- b) The minimum weight for a Commercial Gilt is 160 pounds. There is no maximum weight.
- c) Gilts will be assigned to class by weight by show management.
- d) Commercial gilts will be shown by weight. Classes will be determined by superintendent after weigh-in.
- e) Commercial gilts (limited to two) may also be shown in the market hog show.

Section 3: Market Swine

- a) Junior exhibitors only
- b) An exhibitor may show 2 market hogs.
- c) Market hogs may be gilts or barrows.
- d) Gilts shown in market classes can also be shown in the breeding division (if registered) or commercial gilt division (but not both gilt divisions).
- e) No minimum or maximum weight limits on market hogs, however only hogs weighing between 160-300 lbs will be considered for champion honors.
- f) Market hogs will be shown by weight. Classes will be determined by superintendent after weigh-in.
