Parade Route and Rules

- 1. Participants must be in line-up by 4:45p.m. in the area of the Lonoke City Park (South Center and Academy).
- 2. Bands participating in the parade will receive \$100 per school (one band per school).
- 3. All horses, mules and ponies must have Coggins papers and checked by EIA verifiers before entering the parade according to Act 504. Check point is on the west side of the rodeo parking lot Thursday from 3:30 p.m. 4:30 p.m. Horses and trailers must be off rodeo grounds by 6:30p.m.
- 4. The awards for winning non-commercial floats in the parade will be 1st place-\$75 and 2nd place-\$50.
- 5. 3 and 4 wheelers (ATV'S) are NOT permitted to participate in parade.
- **6.** Motorcycles or UTV's must be driven by licensed driver 25 years or older.
- **7.** Commercial floats are invited to participate in parade, however, not in the contest. Only Non-Commercial floats are eligible for money awards.

Those who wish to compete in Float Contest must submit the Parade Contest form. Deadline is Monday prior to the parade. Everyone else is not required to submit an entry form but are to follow the following line-up guide for the parade.
