RULES

Individual Home Economics Exhibits

Age Divisions: Youth (5-8), Junior Youth (9-13), Senior Youth (14-19), Senior (20 & up)
(Youth 5-8 may exhibit, will be awarded a ribbon but cannot receive points)

Sunday, September 14	
2:00 PM – 5:00 PM	Educational & Community Service Booths may set up
Monday, September 15	
NOON – 2:00 PM	School Arts Registration – Education Building
NOON – 4:00 PM	Educational & Community Service Booths may set up
Tuesday, September 16	
1:00 PM – 7:00 PM	Home Economic Entries (Baked Goods, photography, crafts, horticulture, etc. – except cut flowers) check-in
Wednesday, September 17	
7:30 AM – 8:45 AM	Home Economic Entries: Cut Flowers & Herbs ONLY
Sunday, September 21	
1:00 PM – 4:00 PM	Educational, Horticultural & Home Economic Exhibits Check-out

General Rules:

1. **ONLY ONE (1) ITEM MAY BE ENTERED PER CLASS (NUMBER) IN EACH SECTION.**
2. There will be 4 divisions: Youth 5-8, Jr. Youth 9-13, Sr. Youth 14-19 and Senior 20 and over.
3. Youth (ages 5-8) will be allowed to show in any division. Only ribbons will be awarded, no premium points.
4. Exhibitors must check-in at the door before dropping off their exhibits.
5. Junior exhibitors must live or go to school in Lonoke County or in Pulaski County (north of the Arkansas River).
6. Open Exhibitors must live in Lonoke County or in Pulaski County (north of the Arkansas River).
7. Commercial and professional exhibitors are not permitted to enter exhibits in the Educational and Home Economics area.
8. Points are awarded as designated in the premium list. Exhibits are judged on merit. Those worthy of blue, red, or white premium ribbons will be awarded points, with the exception of youth ages 5-8.
9. The judges will examine items thoroughly. The judge has the authority to disqualify the exhibit if it does not warrant a premium. Judge's decisions are final.
10. Articles not conforming to the sections and classes listed in the catalog can be entered as "other." Only one "other" per section for each exhibitor.

11. Exhibits must be the work of the exhibitor, clean, in first class condition and not shown in a previous Lonoke County Fair.
12. Superintendents for each department have the right to reject any article which they feel does not qualify to show.
13. Judging will begin Wednesday at 9 am. After the conclusion of the judging, exhibits will be open to the public for viewing.
14. The Lonoke County Fair Association will exercise precaution to prevent loss or damage, but will not be responsible should any occur.
15. The Lonoke County Fair Association will not be responsible for exhibits not picked up by 4:00 pm Sunday.
16. Best of show will be awarded in Jr. Youth, Sr. Youth, and Senior division in each department and will receive an additional 3 points if the judges deem approved.

NOTE: When registering online you can only enter ONE item under each class. Class is indicated by the numbered items in each area. Also, be aware of each division for total entries allow
